Why do individuals and groups make mistakes? What are the external and internal factors that lead us to fail? This presentation covers the basics of human performance, influencing factors and the design of tools used to reduce high-impact errors. The discussion will include case studies of the human factors contributing to the 2003 Space Shuttle Columbia loss and the 1986 Chernobyl Nuclear Power Plant disaster.

About the presenter: Lt. Col. Dave Young is the Director of Staff for the Kansas Air National Guard. He advises the Adjutant General and the Commander of the Kansas Air National Guard on all Air National Guard issues. He is responsible for the management of multiple statewide programs and the formulation of long-range plans and strategies for the 2,200 airmen in the 184th Intelligence Wing at McConnell Air Force Base in Wichita and the 190th Air Refueling Wing at Forbes Field in Topeka.
